## Editorial

Kerala government has reached an agreement with the striking teachers of AKPCTA and AKGCT The agreement envisages that all university and college teachers including +2 teachers incolleges wi-Il be enjoying the UGC scales of pay. We congratulate the leadership of AKPCTA and AKGCT and also the government of Kerala for this historic agreement. For teachers in Kerala were not receiving the UGC scales of pay for a rather long time. The UGC scales of pay which came into effect from 1-4-73 were also not implemented in Kerala and with Kerala government accepting the UGC scales of pay, we can now say that the UGC scales of payof 1986 have now been accepted by all the state governments in India. This is no mean achievement for the university and college teachers movement of India because never in the past such a universal coverage could be achieved. AIFUCTO and its constituent units can legitimately take pride in their own achievement. Obviously all problems, are not over. The state government of Bihar is yet to implement the revised scales as per the agreement with the state teachers, leaders Even worse is the situation in Orissa wh ere the state government has again issued a gazette notification seriously modifying the UGC scales to the disadvantage of teachers. There are a lot of unresolved accumulated problems and anomalies concerning teachers at different stages-University Deptt. teachers, Librarians, DP-Es, Demonstrators, Tutors, for College teachers and +2 teachers, counting of past service benefit etc. AIFUCTO is organising a day long Dharna in New Delhi in front of Sastri Bhavan, on 21-5-90 to press upon the Union Government the urg ency to resolve the accumulated problems.

But coming back to Kerala, we would like to congratulate the people of the atate, the government, Kerala Saksharata Samiti, Kerala Shastra Sahithya Parishad our members of university and college teachers, the hundreds of NGOs and thousands of students, school teachers, professionals, workers, trade unionists and millions of common men and women for their tremendous achievement and ambitious plans in the field of literacy. Kerala which is already well ahead of the rest of India in the matter of literacy and education is the first state in our country to show that with the support of the government and involvement of the people it is possible to completely eradicate illiteracy within a short span of time. Ernakulam is the first proud district of India to achieve 98.5% literacy which is same as universal literacy.



#### ORDER

In the G.O. read as 1st paper, Govt. ordered that the U.G. C Scheme including revision of scale of pay will be implemented for teachers of Universities and all affiliated Colleges w. e. f. 1-1-86. In the G. O read as 2nd paper above it was ordered that the College Teachers in Service will be bifurcated as 52% as coming under the Scheme and 48% as not coming under the scheme.

2. In respect of College Teachers coming under the 48% Govt. are pleased to

issue the following further orders:-

- (i) All the College Teachers appointed on permanent posts on regular basis coming under 48% and who were in service as on 1-1-86 will be eligible for salary benefit as per UGC scales with effect from 1-1-1990 as and when they complete eight years of service, to the conditions under the UGC Scheme.
  - (ii) The above benefit will be made available taking into consideration the

length of service.

(iii) The work load prescribed by the U. G. C. Scheme for those category of College Teachers coming under 52% will be made applicable to this category coming under 48% also, as and when they commence to receive U. G. C. scales of pay.

In pursuance of the recommendations made by the committee for redressal of anomalies and grievances constituted as per G.O read as second paper above Govern.

- (1) Pending finalisation of amendments to Special Rules, as well as University Statutes and ordinances and pending identification of the posts under UGC Scheme vacancies of teaching posts in colleges will not ordinarily be filled up until further orders. However, whenever there are vacancies to be filled up in the exigency of service they will be filled up provisionally subject to review under the UGC Scheme.
- (2) The option form appended to the G.O read as first paper is modified as appended to this order.
- (3) In the case of Government College Teachers who were promoted to the various categories of Cadre/Non-cadre on or before 17-6-1987 as mentioned inparas 5.09 and 13.01 of Annexure I of G.O read as first paper above Government order that the Director of Collegiate Education will prepare the pay fixation statements and send to the Accountant General for approval and issue of pay slips. In respect of private College Teachers fixation will be done by the pay fixation cell constituted as per the GO read as second paper above in the Directorate in accordance with the Ready Reckoner approved by Government. The request for review will be considered and decided by Government.
- (4) Pending amendment of special rules, University Statutes ordinances etc. Lecturers who were in service before 1-1-1986 and who are eligible for placement in the senior scale / Selection Grade in accordance with provisions of the scheme, will be provisionally placed accordingly by suspending paras 5.01 (b) and 5.03 (d) of the schedule appended as Annexure 1 to the G.O. read as first paper above till 1-7-1992. By this time, the above teachers who are eligible for placement in the Senior scale / Selection grade will participate in the required number of refresher courses/summer institutes. This exemption will not be applicable to lecturers appointed on or after 1-1 1986.
- (5) Promotion as non cadre professor after 17-6-87 will be dispensed with until further orders.
- (6) Till revised orders are issued, the Senior most persons in the Department. (Subject wise) will function as Heads of Departments in Colleges.

- 6. In respect of Government Colleges, the pay fixation statements relating to the teaching staff will be prepared by the Director to Collegiate Education and sent to the Accountant General for Vertification and issue of pay slips. In the case of Government Law Colleges, the pay fixation will be done by the Principal concerned and sent to the Accountant General for verification and issue of pay slips.
- 7. In respect of Affiliated Private Colleges the pay fixation will be done initially by the Zonal Deputy Directors of Collegiate Education and sent to the pay fixation cell in the Directorate of Collegiate Education. Pay fixation cell will verify the pay fixation statements sent by the Zonal Deputy Directors of Collegiate Education and issue orders.

In respect of teachers in Universities, pay fixation will be done by the University and got approved by the Government Auditor of the respective University.

### APPENDIX

## READY RECKONER

### INTRODUCTION

The Ready Rockoner gives the formula for fixation of pay in the revised scales communicated in the Government of India letter No. F. 1-2/87 U. I. dated 22-7-1988, the method adopted in Kerala for fixing the pay of teachers in the University Grants Commission Scales, Tables showing the fixation of pay of various category of staff coming under the University Grants Commission Scales of pay, the amount of D.A. admissible from various dates, Table showing the D.A admissible from various dates for different stages of the University allowance admissible from time to time and also illustrative examples showing fixation of pay.

## FORMULA FOR FIXATION OF PAY IN THE REVISED SCALES AS PER GOVERNMENT OF INDIA GUIDELINES

- 1. Pay in the revised scales should be fixed under this scheme only after—
- (a) every teacher has had an opportunity to decide whether he/she will opt for the earlier scheme. The option shall be exercised in the prescribed form.

- (b) The University/Government have made necessary changes in their statutes ordinances, rules, regulations, etc., to incorporate the provisions of this scheme.
- 2. The pay of teachers in Universities and Colleges will be fixed in the revised scales of pay in the following manner.
- (i) An amount representing 20% of basic pay in the existing scale shall be added to the "existing emoluments"
- (ii) After the existing emoluments have been so increased, the pay shall be fixed in the revised scale at the stage next above the amount so computed provided that—
- (a) if the minimum of the revised scale is more than the amount so arrived at the pay shall be fixed at the minimum of the revised scale:
- (b) if the amount so arrived at is more than the maximum of the revised scale the pay shall be fixed at the maximum of the scale.

#### Explanation:

- (i) The existing emoluments of a teacher as on I-1-1985 shall include-
  - (a) basic pay:
  - (b) dearness pay, additional dearness allowance and adhoc dearness allowance, if any:
  - (c) interim relief, if any:
- (ii) For the purpose of adding 20% to the existing emoluments:
  - (a) the basic pay shall be the pay on 1-1-1986 in the 1973 U.G.C- scales:
- (b) When a portion of the total emoluments has been merged with the 1973 U.G.C. scales prior to 1-1-1986 the basic pay may be reckoned notionally in the 1973 U.G.C. scales for the purpose of fixation of pay; and
- (c) Where, the 1973 U. G. C scales have not been implemented the actual basic pay, provided that the basic pay in this case does not exceed the notionally arrived at basic pay if 1973 U.G.C. scales had been given.
- Note:—Wherein the fixation of pay of teacher drawing pay at more than five consecutive stages in an existing scale gets bunched, that is to say, gets fixed in the resived scale at the same stage, the pay in the revised scale of such of the teachers who are drawing pay beyond the first five consecutive stages in the existing scale shall be stepped up to the stage where such bunching occurs, as under by the grant of increment (s) in the revised scale in the following manner namely:—
  - (a) for teachers drawing pay from the 6th to the 10th stage in the existing scale-by one increment;
  - (b) for teachers drawing pay from the 11th to 15th stage, in the existing scale If there is bunching beyond the 10th stage—by two increments

(c) for teachers drawing pay from 16th upto 20th stage in the existing scale, if there is bunching beyond the 15th stage by three increments.

If by stepping up of the pay as above, the pay of a teacher gets fixed at a stage in the revised scale which is higher than the stages in the revised scale at which the pay of the teacher who was drawing pay at the next higher stage or stages in the same existing scale is fixed, the pay of the latter shall be stepped up only to the extent by which it falls short of that of the former.

3. The next increment of a teacher whose pay has been fixed 1-1-1986 in the revised scale in accordance with rule 2 shall be granted on the date he would have drawn his increment, had he continued in the existing scale in term of Rule 34 of K.S.R. Part I:

Provided that in cases where the pay of a teacher is stepped up in terms of the note under rule 2 and also in cases when the date of option to U.G.C. scale is a date after 1-1-1986, the next increment shall be granted on the completion of qualifying service of 12 months from the date of stepping up of the pay in the revised scale/date of option to the revised scale.

Provided further that in the case of persons who had been drawing maximum of the existing scale for more than a year as on 1-1-1986, one increment at the rate in the revised scale as on 1-1-1986, shall be reckoned in addition to stepping up of pay if any due to bunching while fixing pay in the revised scale.

The actual amount of Dearnrss Allowance/Additional Dearness Allowance and interim relief admissible in each stage on this account will have to be taken in computing the total existing emoluments and fixing the pay in the revised scale at the appropriate stage.

## METHOD ADOPTED IN KERALA

. From the rules for fixation, the teachers in Kerala come under the third category vide 2 Explanation (ii) C as the U.G.C. scales were not implemented In 1973. Other factors in the fixation remain the same. Under the U.G.C. Scheme, there are restrictions to the amount (20% of the basic pay) to be added to the basic pay as shown below:-

.. Rs. 140 to Rs. 320 .. Rs. 240 to Rs. 380

(i) in the case of Lecturer (ii) in the case of Reader .. Rs. 300 to Rs. 500

(iii) in the case of Professors

The obove have been arrived at from the 20 percent of the minimum and the maximum of the 1973 U.G.C Scales. Since the teachers of Kerala are enjoying scales. scales that are revised twice, the basic pay to be reckoned notionally in the

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1973 scales may be arrived at by deducting the amount merged in the scale at 488 points and 272 points of cost of living index respectively in the reverse direction. This is due to the fact that the two revisions took place by merging the D.A at 272 and 488 points respectively. As an illustration, consider three stages in the scale of a University professor, as given below:—

The resulting scale is comparable to the 1973 U.G.C scale

After arriving at the comparable scale as shown above, 20% of this amount is taken for the purpose of adding 20% of the basic pay. Hence to the basic pay, the 20% obtained as above, and the D. A at 1986 are added to obtain the pay to be used for fixation and the fixation is effected as per the fixation rules laid down by U.G.C. This exercise is carried out for each stage in each scale and given in tables 1 to 12

As you are aware the revised Pay-Scales of Lecturers vide Government of India notification No F.1-21/87-U.1 dated 17th June, 1987/22nd July, 1988 interalia provided for a scheme of Career Advancement leading to the senior scale (Rs. 3000-5000 p.m.) and selection grade (Rs. 3700-5700 p.m.) for Lecturers of the universities and colleges.

The Commission has finalised the guidelines for the implementation of senior scale and selection grade for Lecturers and these are enclosed. The Universities are requested to ensure the implementation of the career advancement schemes as stipulated in these guidelines,

The Commission in its meeting held on 13th December, 1989 agreed that the experience of a person before appointment as a lecturer in the university or college, in equivalent grade in other universities / colleges and the National Laboratories or R & D Organisations (CSIR / ICAR, DRDO, UGC etc.) and UGC Research Scientists be counted as qualifying service for placement in the senior scale / selection grade.

# UNIVERSITY OF CALICUT

Rules for fixation of Seniority of the Teachers in the Affiliated Colleges,

- 1. Every Management shall maintain a seniority list of teachers working in their college/colleges. A Corporate Management shall maintain a separate seniority list of teachers working in the various colleges under their control in this University area.
- 2. All the colleges in the University area under one management shall be considered as one unit for purpose of fixing the seniority of teachers provided the Management is recognised by the University as a Corporate one.
- 3. Transfers from one college to another can be made only if both the colleges are under the same Management. By this transfer the seniority of the teachers concerned shall not be affected.
- 4. In the case of Corporate Management is having Arts/Science, Training and Engineering Collegs, there shall be a common seniority list in subjects which are common to the above colleges.
- 5. Seniority of a teacher in the same cadre /grade in a Department shall be decided with reference to the length of continuous service in that cadre/grade in the Departmets
- 6. In the case of teachers of the same cadre/grade and of the same Department whose date of first appointment is the same, seniority shall be decided on the basis of the rank in the selection list at the time of appointment. If no selection list is maintained, the seniority shall be fixed on the basis of age. The older person shall be senior:
- 7. Date of appointment based on the rank obtained at the time of selection for the post shall be the deciding factor for fixing seniority and not the date of joining duty.
- 8 When a teacher having service in other institutions takes up appointment under a particular college, his continuous service in that particular college alone shall be taken into account for fixing his seniority in that college. However this will not restrict his previous services elsewhere for being counted for fixation of his emoluments, retirement bennifits and such other privileges. In the case of teachers who are confirmed in service in the college and later appointed in another college, the above principle shall be adopted in fixing seniority.
- 9. Retired teachers being reappointed in affiliated colleges shall not be assigned any seniority
- 10. Every teacher shall be placed in the seniority list of the date of his first appointment to the service irrespective of the fact whether the appointment is temporary or on probation or under any exeception, temporary or permanent.
- 11. By adopting the above principles, every management shall prepare a provisonal seniority list of teachers in their colleges within three months from the date on which

these rules came into force and the same shall be circulated to the teachers. Complaints if any received from the teachers within one month from the date of circulation shall be considered and decided by the Management. The decision shall be communicated to the complainants and their acknowledgement obtained.

- 12. 1) In the case of corporate management having colleges under the jurisdiction of the Calicut University and also under jurisdiction of the Kerala University, the Management shall within three months from the date on which these rules come into force prepare a seniority list of the teachers of all such colleges based on the above principles
- 2) After the preparation of the list under sub-section (i) above, the Management, shall give a right of option to the teachers as to the University under the jurisdiction of which they opt to remain and the teachers shall be allotted to each University area n accordance with such option.

Provided that where the number of teachers who have opted to work under the jurisdiction of this University is more than the number required, allotment shall be made on the basis of seniority.

- 3) Teachers shall be permitted to exercise the above option within a period of three months from the date of communication of the seniority list envisaged in sub-sec. (i)
- 4) Taking into account the option received from the teachers, the Management shall prepare the seniority list of teachers in this University area and communicate it to the teachers.

Note:- A teacher who has opted for a particular University area shall be placed in the seniority list for that University area.

- 13) The final list thus prepared by the Management shall be forwarded to the University for its approval.
- 14) Any teacher aggrieved by any entry in the list prepared under section 11 or section 12 may appeal to the Government within sixty days from the date of communication of the list or order of allotment to him and the decision of the Government there in shall be final.
- 15) Where a teacher is allotted to this University area, he shall not be transferred to a college affiliated to any other University. This however will not apply in the case of principals of private colleges.
- The seniority list approved by the University shall be the final list of the college and any additions to this list shall be made subject to University's approval and in strict conformity with these rules.

#### ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Syndicate by virtue of statute 56 of Chapter XLIX of the KERALA University First Statutes 1972, the Syndicate at its meeting held on 23-2-1978 has approved the following rules in modification of the existing Seniority rules as contained in U. O. No. Ac. F. 11-1/1366/68 dated 22-3-1975.

- 1. All managements shall maintain seniority list of teachers working in their colleges affiliated to this University and it should be brought up-to date from time to time.
- 2. (a) All Colleges under a Corporate Management affiliated to this University shall be considered as one unit for fixing the seniority of teachers provided the management is recognised by the University as Corporate.
- (b) Corporate Managements having Arts and Science Colleges, Training Colleges and Engineering Colleges shall maintain a common seniority list in subjects common to the above colleges.

Provided however, that if before the commencement of these rules, the corporate management has treated training. Engineering and Womens' Colleges as separate units and has been so recognised by the University, such college/colleges shall continue to be so and a separate seniority list for each of such colleges shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions laid down in these rules.

- 3 (a) Seniority of a teacher in the same cadre in a subject under a management shall be decided with respect to the total period of service in that cadre in the subject, provided he/she is duly qualified or exempted by the competent authority from the possession of the minimum qualifications prescribed for the post.
- (b) For the purpose of (a) above, while calculating the total period of service of teachers, the service put in by a teacher prior to a 'Break in Service' which exceeds two years at a time will not be reckoned.
- (c) The management shall also prepare a general seniority list of all the teachers, cadre-wise.
- 4. Where the date of first appointment is the same, seniority of a teacher in a cadre shall be determined on the basis of the rank in the selection list and where no selection list is maintained, seniority shall be fixed on the basis of age, the older person shall be senior.

Provided however, in the case of promotions from one cadre to the other effected on the same date, their relative seniority in the lower cadre shall be maintained in the promoted cadre, as well.

- 5. The date of appointment or the rank obtained in the selection list for the post shall be the deciding factor for fixing the seniority and not the date of joiningduty
- 6. When the teachers with previous service in the same institution or under the same management are re-appointed after a break, their relative seniority will or under the same mrnagement, the person having the longer period of prior service being treated as senior
- 7. (a) When a teacher having service in other institutions take up appointment under a particular management his/her service in that particular management alone shall be taken into account to fix his/her seniority
- (b) Seniority of a teacher appointed to a college newly started by an educational agency shall be decided with refrence to the length of total previous service, if any, in the same grade or cadre under any other educational agency or corporate management as the case may be, reckoned on the first working day of the college, provided he/she joints duty on the first working day. (subject to the provision in (a) above)
- 8 Transfers from one college to another shall be made only if both the colleges are under a corporate management and affilliated to this University but such transfers shall not affect the seniority of the teachers.
- 9 When a teacher working in a college under a particular Management takes up appointment in another college under a new Management, he/she shall take his/her place as the junior most in the particular cadre in the Department concerned, but he/she shall be entitled to the protection of the emoluments drawn by him/her earlier.
- 10 Retired teachers from Government Colleges and other institutions who take up appointments in Private Colleges shall not be assigned any seniority.
- Il Every teacher shall be placed in the 'seniority lists' on the date of his/her first appointment to the service, irrespective of the fact that the appointment is temporary or on probation or under any exemption, temporary or permanent.
- 12 Every Management shall prepare 'provisional seniority lists' of teachers in their colleges within 3 months from the date on which these rules come in to force. The lists so prepared shall be circulated among the teachers. Complaints if any, received from the teachers within one month of its circulation, shall be considered and decided by the management within one month of their receipt and its decision on the complaints communicated to the teachers concerned. The 'seniority' lists' thus finalised shall be forwarded to the University within two months for approval by the Syndicate.

- 13 The teachers are entitled to appeal before the Vice-Chancellor against the decision of the Management within one month from the date of receipt of the final decision of the Management. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor on the appeal shall be final.
- 14 The seniority lists shall be approved by the Syndicate after making the necessary alterations, if any found, as per the above rules.
- 15 The 'seniority lists' approved by the Syndicate shall be the final lists and any addition to the lists shall be made subject to the approval by the Syndicate and in strict conformity with these rules.

The Managements of all affiliated private colleges within the territorial jurisidiction of this University shall follow the above rules scrupulously.

Note: Notwithstanding anything contained in the above, the seniority of a teacher already fixed prior to the commencement of these rules shall not be disturbed.

These rules will be effective from 23-2-1978




